Start at www.mnps.org

At this website click on "Programs" at the top. Then click on "Academic Standards" and you can choose which subject and which grade level you are interested in. Here you can find the actual Tennessee State Standards.

At this website there is a Guest Access box on the right side. Type in "courseoutlines" into the guest name and click "Visit." Then you can specify your grade and nine weeks that you are interested in. Here you can learn what students are learning in their classes and the standards that match the topics being taught.
