February 1	 All districts/schools must provide parent notification for any student who is at-risk for retention These notifications should be attached to the Home Literacy Report required for students with a significant reading deficiency Recommended attachment: Summer Programming Application (for pre-planning in staffing and budget and prioritizing conversations with families) 	Launch of District Summer Programming Prioritized Registration Recommend Additional Literacy Acceleration for At-Risk Students: • High-dosage, low-ratio tutoring • Literacy grants to families for after-school tutoring • Partnerships with after-school providers to support literacy • RTI ² programming adjustments
April 10 - May 12	Spring Universal Reading Screener Assessment (K-2 Pre and Post Assessment-Adequate Growth)	
April 17 - May 2	3 rd Grade ELA TCAP Testing Window	
May 19	3 rd Grade ELA TCAP Raw Score Files and a Single Proficiency Cut Score Released to Districts	This information may be used to begin identifying students who did not reach the proficiency cut score for the purposes of the 3rd grade ELA TCAP retake and to communicate with parents. It will not distinguish for districts whether a non-proficient student is in the approaching vs. below performance levels.
May 22 – June 5	3 rd Grade ELA TCAP Retake Window	
May 26	Raw Score to Scale Score Conversion Tables Released to Districts for all Grades and Performance Levels	Districts will be able to distinguish whether 3rd grade students identified as non-proficient based on raw scores were in the approaching or below performance level based off their TCAP results.

May 30 – June 13	Parent Appeal Window (Parents have 14 days to complete an appeal)	Per State Board of Education rules, an appeal can be submitted by a parent or legal guardian to the Department within fourteen (14) calendar days of receipt of the notice from the LEA or public charter school that the student is identified as at-risk for retention based on the student achieving a performance level rating of approaching on the ELA portion of the student's most recent TCAP test.
June 7	All 3 rd Grade ELA TCAP Retake Scores Reported	
June 13	Summer Camp Post-test Opens	
June 24	Final Retention Notification for Families *This is for families who <u>did not</u> participate in the intervention pathways.	This date applies for schools starting July 24. If school starts later, notification to families must be disseminated at least 30 days before the first day of school.
July 14	Final Retention Notification for Families *This is for families who participated in the summer programming intervention pathway.	This date applies for schools starting July 24. If school starts later, notification to families must be disseminated at least 10 days before the first day of school.



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
